CAN YOU HEAR ME NOW?

John 10:27

Sermon by Dr. Mike Auten

Introduction: A skit built around a "phone call from heaven" where a person gets a phone call and doesn't recognize the voice of the one calling and when asks who is calling, the reply - "It's God!" Then the conversation goes on about how God has been missing conversations, visits, etc....from this person. Use your own imagination as to how a real phone call from God might be and what the conversation would be about.

I. WHY WOULD GOD WANT TO SPEAK TO ME?

- 1. God created you to be a part of His family (1 John 3:1)
- 2. You need direction for your life. (John 14:26)
- 3. There are times you need: comfort, peace, assurance, courage, etc.. (2 Corinthians 7:5-6)

II. WHY DOES GOID TALK TO ME?

- 1. Examples in the Bible: visions *Genesis 15*, dreams *Genesis 37*, burning bush *Exodus 3*, storm *Exodus 19*, written word *Exodus 20*, donkey *Numbers 22*, gentle whisper *1 Kings 19*, a sign *Judges 6*, hand writing on a wall *Daniel 5*, Angels *Luke 1*, prophets *Hebrews 1*
- 2. Three primary ways God speaks to you:
 - The Bible (Hebrews 4:12)
 - The Holy Spirit (John 16:13)
 - Circumstances (Acts 16, Jonah 2, Daniel 6)

III. WHY CAN'T I HEAR GOD?

- 1. Three spiritual blocks or barriers:
 - You don't know God personally (John 14:6-7; 10:27)
 - Un-confessed or un-repented sin (Psalm 66:18)
 - You have a wrong focus in life (Romans 12:2)

IV. HOW SHOULD I LISTEN TO GOD?

- 1. There are some intentional ways to sharpen your listening skills.
 - Listen:
 - Expectantly (Jeremiah 33:3)
 - Quietly (Psalm 46:10)
 - Actively (Colossians 3:16)
 - Openly (1 Corinthians 2:12)
 - Submissively (Matthew 26:39)
 - Thankfully (Philippians 4:6-7)
 - Patiently (Isaiah 30:18)

CONCLUSION:

1. An assignment question: "How do I know the voice I hear is God's voice and not my own or someone else's?"
